Santa Rosa Symphony Single Tickets On Sale September 1

SANTA ROSA, CA – Single tickets for the entire array of Santa Rosa Symphony concerts and events during the 2009-2010 “Music That Makes A Difference” season go on sale Tuesday, September 1.

Prices range from \$27-\$55 (with senior discounts available).

Music Director Bruno Ferrandis steps onto the podium at the Wells Fargo Center for the Arts on October 10-12 to kick off the Symphony’s 82nd season with a Russian program highlighted by former SRS Music Director and brilliant pianist Jeffrey Kahane playing the “Rach 3” (Rachmaninoff’s Piano Concerto No. 3).

Kahane will also perform Friday, October 9 at the Symphony’s annual fundraising dinner and auction, titled “Russian Rhapsody” in thematic accord with the season-opening program. The black tie gala takes place at the Santa Rosa Golf and Country Club beginning at 6 p.m. with tickets at \$200 per person for wine, dinner, music by Kahane and dance music by Orient Express.
