Play On! Golf Tournament April 26 benefits Santa Rosa Symphony Youth Ensembles

Event at Oakmont Golf Club includes reception, dinner and musical entertainment

(SANTA ROSA, CA) The Santa Rosa Symphony Education Department is hosting its 5th **Annual Play On! Golf Tournament** on **Monday, April 26, 2010** on the West Course of the Oakmont Golf Club in Santa Rosa. The event benefits the Symphony's 4 Youth Ensembles (Preparatory and Discovery orchestras, the Youth Orchestra and the Young People's Chamber Orchestra).

The **Individual Golfer** rate includes green fees, golf cart, a post-tournament reception and dinner with entertainment by the young musicians. Player check-in begins at 11:30 a.m. followed by a "shot gun start" at 1 p.m. Singles are welcome. Cost is \$150 per player before April 1 and \$160 thereafter.

Supporters who don't know a putter from a 3-iron may join the benefit as a dinner guest only for \$30 (choice of chicken, tri-tip or vegetarian entrée). The wine reception and dinner begins at 6 p.m.
