#### **Brief Bio - Bruno Ferrandis**

Bruno Ferrandis began his tenure as music director and conductor of the Santa Rosa Symphony in Fall 2006. He was born in Algiers in 1960, raised in Nice, France, and currently resides in Paris with his family. Maestro Ferrandis has conducted all over the world, and his breadth of musical experience includes not only symphony and opera, but also ballet, musical theater and cinema-accompanying music. A graduate of the Guildhall School of Music and Drama in London, he received a Master’s degree in conducting from the Juilliard School. He was conductor of the Juilliard Pre-College Orchestra and the Juilliard Opera Center. He also co-founded the New Music ensemble “Music Mobile” in New York City and has recorded three compact discs with the Radio France Orchestra.
