Santa Rosa Symphony Young People's Chamber Orchestra and Preparatory Orchestra present Fall Concert Nov. 20

(SANTA ROSA, CA) — Two Santa Rosa Symphony Youth Ensembles will share their first concert this Fall at the Glaser Center, 547 Mendocino Avenue in Santa Rosa on November 20, 2010, at 2 p.m. Young People's Chamber Orchestra (YPCO) is a conductorless string ensemble of 17 musicians ranging in age from 9 to 17. The SRS Preparatory Orchestra provides a rich, rewarding educational experience for 35 young musicians ages 6 to 13 who wish to play with a full orchestra.

On the YPCO program is a Concerto No. 5 in D major by Muffat; Sinfonia in E minor by C.P.E. Bach; String Sextet by Brahms and *Paranoid Android* by Radiohead.

On the PO program is *Marche Militaire Française* by Saint-Saëns; *Little Suite for Orchestra* by Corelli; Allegro from *Saint Cecelia Mass* by Gounoud; and *Procession of the Sardar* by Ippolitov-Ivanov. The Preparatory Orchestra is conducted by long-time Santa Rosa Symphony violinist William R. "Bob" Williams.

The Young People's Chamber Orchestra, established in 1998, welcomes acting director Aaron Westman for its Fall season. Westman has performed as a soloist and principal player for many Bay Area ensembles and performs with the Philharmonia Baroque Orchestra, Musica Angelica, the Los Angeles Master Chorale and others. He is also a teacher, a substitute player for the Santa Rosa Symphony, and is a graduate of the Santa Rosa and San Francisco Symphony youth orchestra programs.

Admission to the Young People's Chamber Orchestra and Discovery Orchestra joint concert is \$12 for adults and \$10 for seniors/students and group sales of 10 or more \$8 each. Tickets can be purchased through the Santa Rosa Symphony Patron Office (707) 54-MUSIC, or at the door, subject to availability.
